Did you know that every summer, high school and college students are trained by CEF to become summer missionaries through *Christian Youth In Action (CYIA)*?

What is CYIA?

Then all summer long, they put their skills to work by leading 5-Day Clubs and Vacation Bible Schools (VBS) right here in Delaware County.
